

The Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) is a **free** application that collects information to help determine eligibility for state (or institutional) financial aid programs administered by institutions of higher education in the state of Texas. Students classified as Texas residents who are not eligible to apply for federal financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) are encouraged to complete the TASFA. If you're not sure which application (TASFA or FAFSA) to complete, use the [TASFA Decision Tool](#).

You do not need to complete both the FAFSA and TASFA.

Contact the college you plan to attend to confirm final deadlines since they can vary. Students should apply as soon as possible to maximize their state financial aid options since funding is limited.
